Make sure that your bag is not too big!! Our cloak-rooms are quite small.



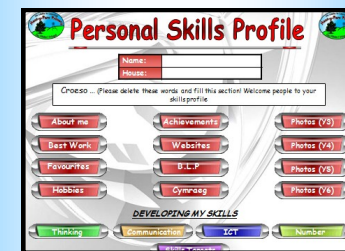
What will I learn at Nant-y-Parc?

Yes - we have a really good school council. Every September, a new school council is elected and they work really hard during the year, trying to raise money for charity and making our school better for us.

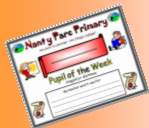


What is there to do at playtimes / lunchtimes?

Is there a Breakfast Club?



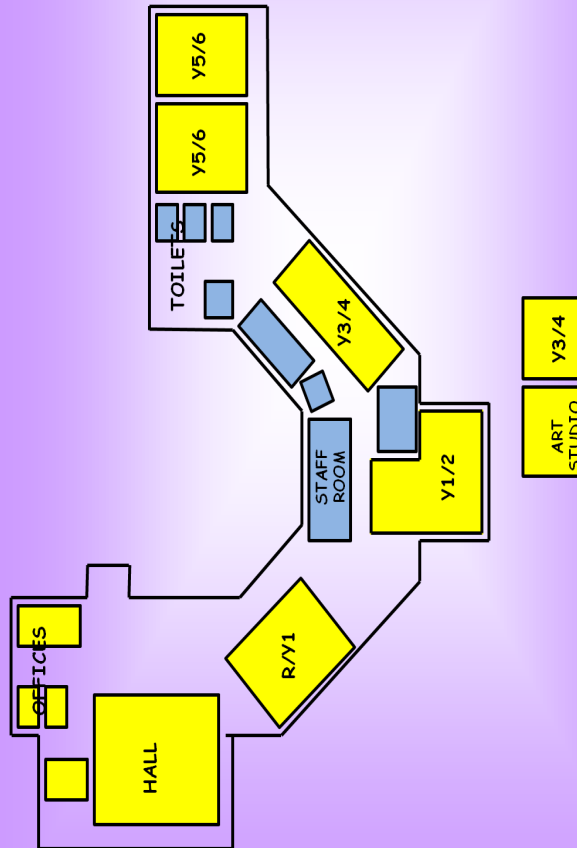
